REPORT

The Alumni Peer Interaction Meet was organized by the Department of Computer Applications under the guidance of Dr. Rajiv Kumar, Dean of the School of Computing at RIMT University, on 15th July 2025. The event was coordinated by Ms. Sunaina Bagga and Mr. Iqbal Singh, Assistant Professor in the Department of Computer Applications, and began at 11:30 AM. The discussion centered on the significance of strong alumni networks and the importance of maintaining relationships between the university and its students. The session highlighted the university's mission to nurture and guide young minds, helping them shape their academic and professional careers.

The session featured insightful contributions from three invited alumni: Mr. Sukhdeep Singh (MCA Batch 2020-2022), currently working as a Software Developer at Bita Soft, where he works with technologies such as HTML/CSS, Java Script, Java, Spring Boot, and MySQL; Ms. Rajni Dhaliwal (BCA Batch 2017-2021), a Manager at a private company in Jaipur, who shared her experience in project management using tools like Microsoft Office Suite, Power Bi and CRM software; and Mr. Mayanglambam Nerish Singh (B.Sc. AM Batch 2022), a Graphics Designer at Rankingeek Market Agency in Delhi, who utilizes Adobe Creative Suite, including Photoshop, Illustrator, and After Effects, in his daily work. Each alumnus shared their journey from RIMT University to their current roles, offering practical insights into market expectations, industry tools, and evolving job dynamics. They also expressed their willingness to assist current students with placement and internship opportunities. The session concluded with a vote of thanks from Dr. Rajiv Kumar. The meet was attended by over 50 participants.

Ms. Sunaina Bagga and Mr. Iqbal Singh emphasized the importance of alumni engagement in providing industry-relevant knowledge, mentorship, and job placement guidance. 

OUTCOME:
