# Webinar on Hepatitis infection & public health: An open challenge

Dr. Sandeep Sharma, Associate Professor, LPU discussed that viral hepatitis is one of the emerging public health problems, which urgently needs special attention. He added that it belongs to the rare group of diseases that can cause chronic inflammation inside the body, and it can have a delayed presentation and it also contributes substantially to the global burden on healthcare. Dr.Sharma added that despite having prevalence rates similar to HIV, tuberculosis, and malaria, political commitment and efforts made in the direction of prevention and control of viral hepatitis need more attention.

# Webinar on a Grain saved is a Grain Produced
