- Two copies of approved synopsis along with one soft copy shall be submitted in the office of Dean Research for official record.
- **Modification of the Title/Scheme:**
 - * A Candidate may, within two years of his /her registration modify the title/scheme of his/her research proposal with the approval of Research Advisory Committee and payment of prescribed fee. Provided that the RAC will allow only such modifications



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which will not involve any major change in the original scheme and scope of the subject.

*The date of registration and the maximum period allowable for research completion will generally remain unchanged.
